Pheromones: How they work

Pheromones are naturally produced chemical substances that are instantly recognisable between animals of the same species. Different pheromones trigger a specific instinctive response from the animal.

When nursing her puppies, the bitch produces Dog Appeasing Pheromones. These pheromones trigger an instinctive calming response, helping the puppies feel safe and reassured, and is a crucial part of the bonding process.

When dogs feel comfortable and reassured, they are less likely to exhibit problem behaviour, such as furniture destruction or urinary marking.

By using a copy of the Dog Appeasing Pheromone in the **Beaphar CaniComfort® Calming Range**, we can mimic this calming effect, providing dogs with a message of continuous reassurance. This allows dogs to feel more relaxed and comfortable, helping to reduce problem behaviour. Because the Dog Appeasing Pheromone triggers an instinctive response, this means it can be identified by dogs of all breeds and ages, and regardless of whether they were hand-reared or nursed from the bitch.

Long-term stress in dogs can occasionally lead to clinical illness, so it is important that owners do all they can to help their dogs feel calm and reassured. This can be particularly important during stressful situations, such as firework season, or times of upheaval, such as moving house or the addition of a new pet or family member.

Signs of stress

Is your dog showing any of the following? If they are, it could be because they are trying to tell you that something is making them feel unsettled or worried.



Destructive behaviour



Continuous barking

Other signs of stress may be urinary marking, eating or drinking less, restlessness, hiding away and excessive licking.

Not all problem behaviour in dogs is caused by stress or a stressful situation, in which case Beaphar CaniComfort® may not produce the desired calming effect.

Such situations include:

- Poor or inconsistent training, and a lack of mental stimulation can lead to over-excitement, barking or destructive behaviour.
- A lack of house training or an underlying medical condition may cause your dog to urinate indoors or in inappropriate places.
- An underlying medical condition or irritation from external parasites may cause excessive licking and scratching.
