# From Marabu you will need...

- Decormatt Acryl in aubergine (039), medium brown (040), peach (224), crocus (089)
- Decorlack Acryl in white (070), black (073), pink (033), gold (784)
- DecorGlitter in gold (583)
- DecorGlitter-Glue
- Stencil "Snow Flakes"
- Fix-it adhesive spray Hobby brush, flat, size 12
- Stencilling brush, size 6

## ...you will also need:

- A sheet of plywood, approx. 5 mm thick
- Jigsaw or fretsaw
- Fine sandpaper
- Cocktail stick
- Tracing paper, pencil

### Here's how it's done:

- 1. Copy the pattern onto the sheet of plywood using tracing paper and saw out the shape. Smooth the wood using sandpaper, especially the edges.
- 2. Prime the angel in crocus on both sides. Allow to dry. If necessary, copy the lines for the details (hairs, shoes etc.) again.
- **3.** Paint these areas in the corresponding colours: shoes in aubergine, hair in medium brown, skin in peach, for example.
- **4.** Paint the wings and the halo with Decorlack Acryl gold. When dry, spread DecorGlitter-Glue and sprinkle DecorGlitter on them. Tap off excess glitter.
- 5. The face is painted with little dots using a cocktail stick dipped into the paint. The bow and the patterns are also painted with little dots. Allow everything to dry.
- 6. Spray a thin coat of Fix-it on the stencil and allow to flash off. Then place the stencil onto the angel. Stencil a snowflake using a stencilling brush and DecorGlitter-Glue. Sprinkle the snowflake with DecorGlitter gold. Remove stencil, tap off excess glitter and allow everything to dry well.

Alternatively, the stencil motif can be stencilled with Marabu-Glitter Liner gold or Marabu-Acrylic-Effects glitter-gold.
