


## From Marabu you will need...

- Marabu-easy marble in ruby red (038), rose pink (033), medium brown (040) and clear (100)


## ...you will also need:

- Plastic eggs
- Water containers
- Wooden sticks
- Gloves
- Old newspaper, paper


## Here's how it's done:

1. Fill a marbling container with water at room temperature. Cover the table with newspaper. Firmly place the egg on a wooden stick.
2. First shake the paints well. Drip several drops of the paint directly from the jar onto the surface of the water.
3. Drip further shades of paint into this colour area as you choose. 2-3 colours are ideal. Swirl the paint immediately using a cocktail stick to create any patterns you like.
4. Dip the egg slowly into the container until it is submerged completely in the water. The paint wraps round the egg like a thin film. Then remove the egg quickly and hang up for drying (e.g. into an old box).
5. Finally remove surplus paint from the surface of the water using a piece of paper (keep hold of the edge).

Tip:

- When marbling, always work quickly, as the paint will develop a film over the surface after a few minutes and can no longer be used.
