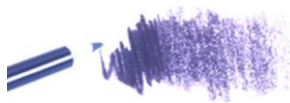

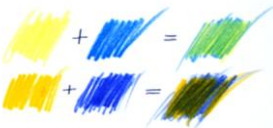

Practical Demo Exercise #1



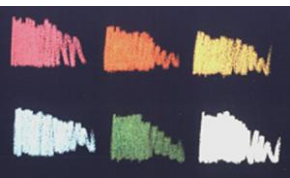
Use a dark colored pencil and color an area with a switch from light shading to intense color. For a light shade, hold the pencil very flat. For intense color contrast, hold the pencil almost vertical.

Practical Demo Exercise #2



Draw different shades of different colors over each other. Hold the pencil at a very flat angle. Always work from light to dark color, so that the lines are visible and the colors are brilliant! Recognize how the colors can be mixed into each other without smudging.

Practical Demo Exercise #3



Use bright colors on dark paper to demonstrate color opacity.
