Porcelain and Glas Painter - Dishwasher-safe without oven fixing!





Here's how it's done - easy and quickly:

- 1. Pre-cleaning of crockery is very important and the best possible result can be achieved using a scouring agent and a small sponge. Afterwards they should be wiped with Marabu-Cleaner & Thinner or White Spirit to remove any fingerprints.
- 2. Press onto the tip repeatedly until the ink is visible in it or stir the paint and start painting.
- 3. The painted item is ready for use after a drying time of 3 days.
- 4. Dishwasher-safe (max. 50 °C)



Additional information:

- To reduce the drying time, the painted object can be dried for 30 minutes at 100°C in the oven.
- Always make sure that the cutting surfaces, drinking rims or the insides of plates and cups are not painted, as abrasion can damage the design.
- Arcopal crockery is not suitable for painting with Porcelain and Glas Painters, as dishwasher-resistance cannot be guaranteed.
