Tips and tricks:

1. The porcelain surface should be cleaned with hot water and detergent or Marabu-Cleaner so that it is dust and grease-free. Rinse off Cleaner residues thoroughly before you start painting.
2. The paint is touch-dry after 30 minutes, dishwasher-safe after 3 days.
3. We recommend rinsing your painted crockery in the programme for glasses/cups at a maximum 40°C.
4. If Marabu-Porcelain is combined with colour systems which must be cured in the oven, allow Marabu-Porcelain to dry for 1 hour and then heat in an oven (30 min. at 150°C). Additional curing will not improve adhesion.
5. It is possible to make corrections or completely remove the paint applied without any problems provided the paint has not dried. For this, use e.g. a cotton bud with Marabu-Cleaner or White Spirit.
6. Do not paint the cutting surfaces or drinking rims of crockery, as abrasion can damage the design.

Even beginners can obtain great results using easy techniques like stamping or stencilling. Original designs can be painted with a brush.

Here's how it's done: Porcelain painting techniques

Free-hand painting

Use a soft brush - we recommend Marabu-Fino or Marabu-Universal - the high-gloss porcelain paint can be applied easily on smooth surfaces.

A light glaze or full coverage, application to the entire surface or highlights here and there.



Dabbing, application to the entire surface

To obtain particularly fine surfaces with delicate colour flows, the porcelain paint should be dabbed on. Gently dab the stencilling sponge from Marabu into some paint, wait briefly, then dab over the surface without using additional paint. Small air bubbles are avoided this way. You can also combine several colours for this technique. A great frost effect is obtained when Marabu-Porcelain is dabbed on glass.



Painting outlines

Using Marabu-Relief Paste, the motif can be painted directly from the tube. As soon as the outlines have dried, you can colour it in using Marabu-Porcelain and a fine synthetic hair brush.



Stencilling

Using self-adhesive stencils from Marabu, even complicated designs can be achieved. You will find detailed instructions on each Adhesive Stencil.

Scratching technique

Dabbed surfaces are perfect for "scratching" patterns and motifs into the wet paint using e.g. a cotton bud or a toothpick.



Stamping

Marabu offers a wide range of mini stamps which are ideal for glass and porcelain painting. You will find detailed instructions on the mini stamps packaging.
