


Instructions: The Frog Prince



Begin by making three balls. Make an egg-shaped body out of the first ball. Make the second one slightly flatter on one side - this one is for the head. Cut the third ball in half and press the pieces onto the head.



Make the eyes and mouth using the modelling stick.




Use two half-strips of FIMO soft to make two smaller balls with. These are for the legs. Fold them upwards getting smaller towards the top so that they look like they are in a sitting position. Use the modelling stick to make indents for the little toes.



Now press the legs onto the side of the body.



Thanks to the portioning aid, it's easy to cut your block of FIMO into the right portions.



Shape small balls for the arms. Roll them to make two approx. 3 cm long snakes. Cross the front ends over and bend the back ones towards the rear.




Carefully attach the arms to the body using a modelling stick - then it's off into the oven it goes. Leave the frog to harden for 30 minutes at 110°C.


Doves, enchanted well, golden ball...



1 Make a ball out of a small 6-7 mm piece of white FIMO soft (8020-0), mould it into a tear-shaped body, add a gold-coloured beak, finished!



1 Roll out an approx. 8 mm thick sheet, shape it to a ring, smooth over the join and carve stone-looking grooves into the clay using the modelling stick.



1 Shape individual blades of grass out of a strip of apple green FIMO soft (8020-50) and group them together however you like to make tufts of grass. Finish off by hardening the dove, well and grass in the oven for 30 minutes at 110 °C.
