You will also require: Smooth work surface (glass or ceramic), Paper, (A4, white), Scissors, Ribbon (red & white checks), Kitchen knife, White acrylic paint, Brush, Baking tray and baking paper, Hot glue gun, Double-sided sticky tape

## Instruction for FIMO tattoos - Alpine paradise



For the FIMO soft 'antler' tattoo take four standard blocks of caramel FIMO soft and roll each of them out to a sheet using the acrylic roller first and then the clay machine on setting 1. Place one sheet of FIMO soft vertically onto another sheet of FIMO soft, overlapping slightly. Then fold the sheets of FIMO soft over horizontally, roll out on setting 1 and then fold and roll out again until you are left with one large smooth sheet (approx. 32 x 17 cm).

Place the sheet of FIMO soft on the baking paper. Then emboss the whole sheet of FIMO soft using the 'wood' texture sheet. Always spray the texture sheet with a little water before placing the embossed side face down onto the sheet of FIMO soft, then roll over the texture sheet firmly using the acrylic roller. Carefully remove the sheet.



Print out the pattern sheet for the antlers and cut the paper motif (template) out. Place the template onto the embossed sheet of FIMO soft and press on gently with your finger to make the paper stick. Next, cut the motif out of the sheet of FIMO soft by going around the edges of the template with the kitchen knife. Peel the template off.

Remove the surplus modelling clay and use it to create another large sheet together with the remaining three standard blocks of caramel FIMO soft. Emboss this sheet of FIMO soft using the 'wood' texture sheet too, place the template on again (this time the other way round) and cut the antler motif out of the sheet of FIMO soft.



Harden the two-piece FIMO soft antlers in the oven for approx. 30 minutes at 110°C, take out and leave to cool. Next, paint the textured fronts of the tattoos using the white acrylic paint.

Create an antique effect by using a sanding sponge to slightly sand paint off the elevated parts of the motif. Then varnish and decorate with bows.

**Tip:**

Unfinished items and left-over bits of material can be stored in a sealed plastic bag or airtight container, e.g. a plastic box or jar.

## Instruction for FIMO tattoos - Alpine paradise



Print out the pattern sheets for the heart and edelweiss and cut the paper motifs out. For the 'sweetheart' FIMO effect tattoo, roll two standard blocks of glitter red FIMO effect out to a sheet. Place the heart template on top and cut the heart out of the sheet of FIMO effect. Use white FIMO soft to make tiny balls and place them on the heart.

Press them flat to create a polka-dot look. For the twisted cord trim, use your hands to roll 2 strips of aqua FIMO effect into an approx. 60 cm long sausage (5 mm in diameter), fold in half and twist into a spiral. Place the FIMO effect cord around the edge of the heart and press on with your fingers.



Roll the rest of the white FIMO soft out to a sheet using the clay machine on setting 1 and then place it on the baking paper. Print out the pattern sheet for the FIMO soft edelweiss tattoo and cut the motif out. Using it as a template, place it on the sheet of FIMO soft and cut the motif out of the modelling clay. Position the FIMO soft edelweiss on the FIMO effect heart. Use small bits of white FIMO soft to shape pointed oval petals and press these onto the edelweiss tattoo. For the centre of the flower, make small balls out of glitter gold FIMO effect and press them onto the middle.

Harden the finished 'sweetheart' FIMO soft tattoo in the oven for approx. 30 minutes at 110°C, varnish it and stick it on the wall together with the 'antlers' FIMO soft tattoo using double-sided sticky tape.



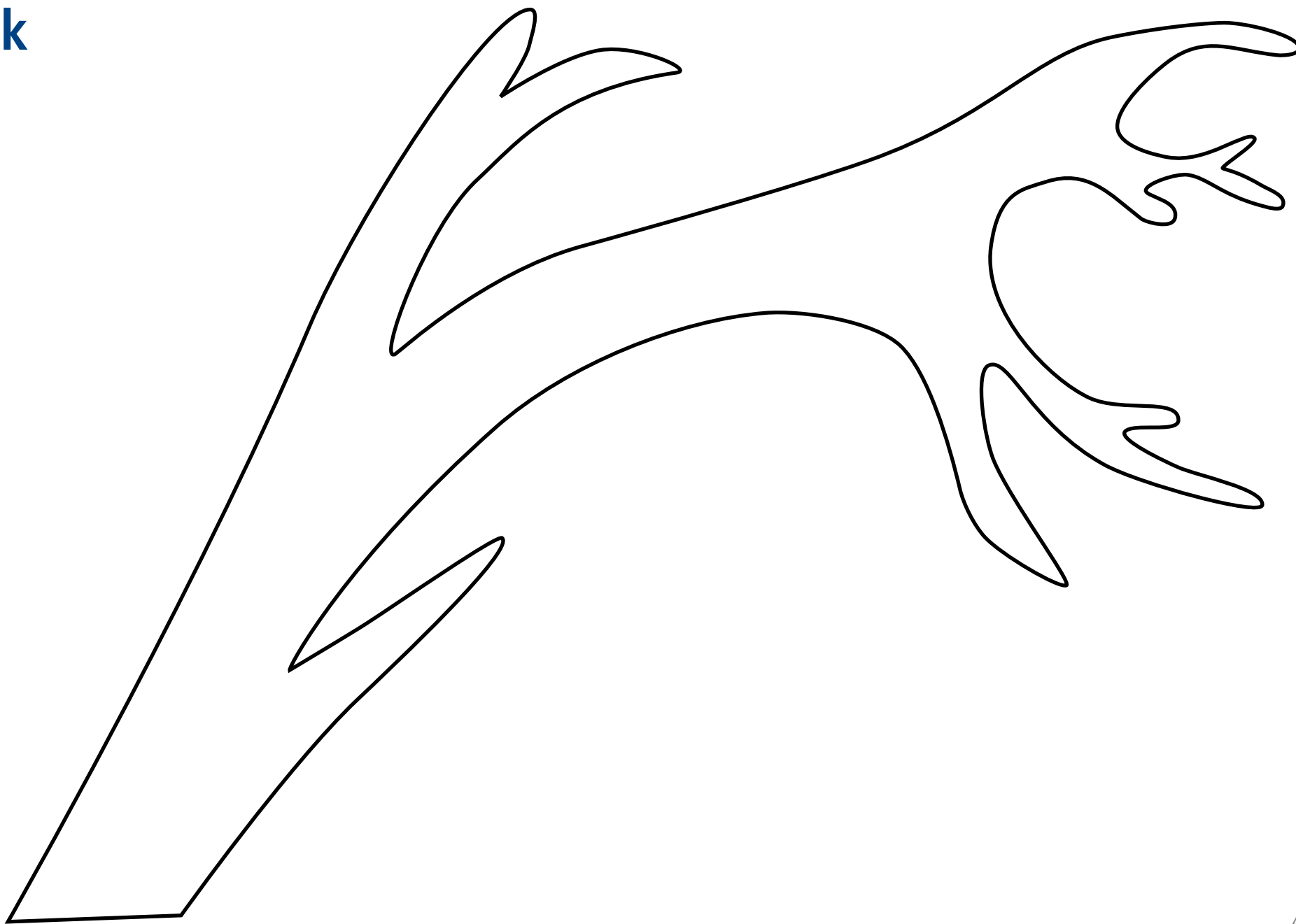
**Tip:**

The FIMO antlers look good on a stag's head too. This trendy silhouette look is most effective when made with black FIMO soft.

One large 350 g block of black FIMO soft (8022-9) is ideal for the making this three-piece tattoo. The silhouette tattoo's impressive wood-like finish is created using the 'wood' texture sheet as well.

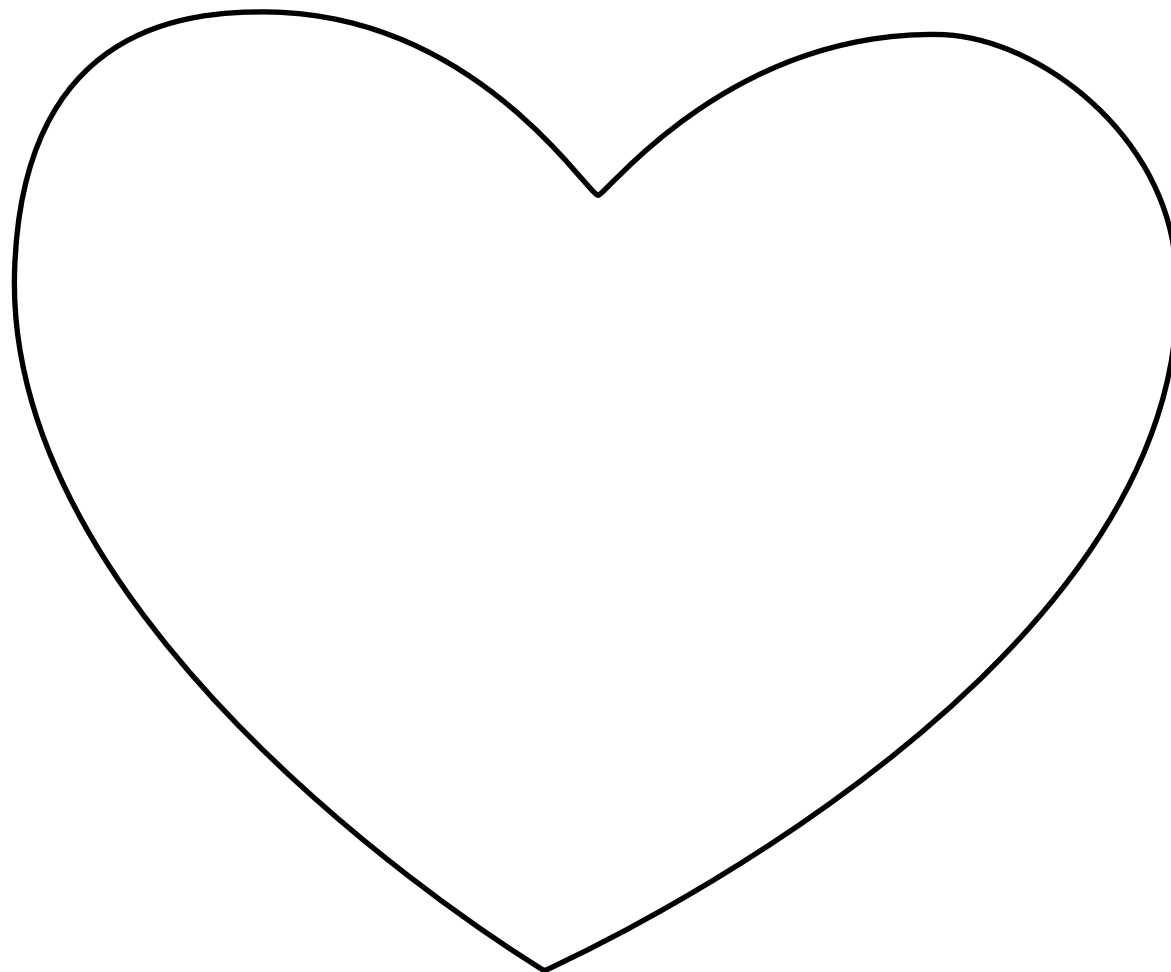
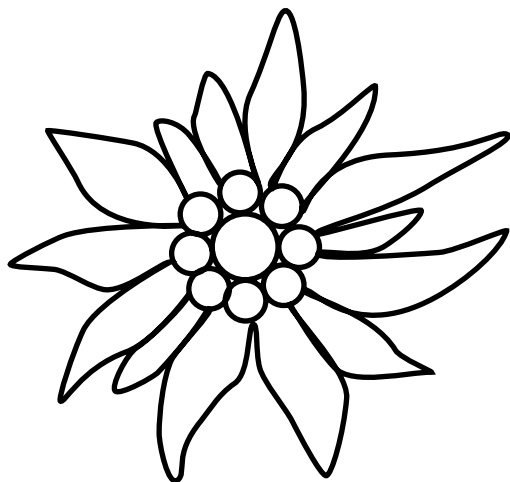
