

# Fun ideas to make yourself





A baby elephant for you!







# From Marabu you will need...

- Marabu-Textil plus light blue (090), dark violet (051) and white (070)
- Marabu-Fix-it adhesive spray, 150 ml
  Marabu-Stencil "Baby Elephants" (018), 15 x 33 cm
- Marabu-Stencilling Brush Set (3 stencilling brushes)

### ...you will also need:

- Shirt, trousers, cushion
- Masking tape
- A sheed of card

## Here's how it's done:

- Before painting wash out dressing residues of textiles completely - do not use fabric softener. Afterwards allow to dry and iron the fabric smooth. Next insert a sheet of card inside or under the fabric so that the paint does not transfer through the back. Now stretch the fabric onto a smooth support using masking tape so that it is lying evenly on the surface.
- **2.** Then spray stencil thinly with Fix-it adhesive spray, allow to dry briefly and place it in the chosen position onto the textile.
- 3. Dab Textil plus paint in the chosen colours onto the fabric using a brush. As long as the paint is still wet, gradations in colours can be obtained. (Clean stencil thoroughly before starting to stencil again so that the fabric will not get spoiled.)
- 4. Allow the fabric to dry for 6 hours in a flat, stretched position. Then iron each painted area from the front, through a thin cloth or baking paper for 5 min. per 50 cm on cotton setting or fix in a pre-heated oven for 8 min. at 150°C. (Test fabric for heat resistance first.) Then the item is wash-resistant up to 40°C.

### Tip:

Simply mix the Textil plus colour shade yourself depending on the colour of the shirt. By adding some white, violet turns into a beautiful lilac shade in no time!
